



**JOB DESCRIPTION  
PLANT HEALTH CARE TECHNICIAN**

1. Serve as a plant health care technician with the primary responsibilities of inspecting landscapes, sampling, applying treatments, inventory, equipment maintenance, record keeping, and customer relations.
  - Be familiar with products and techniques used to maintain plant health;
  - Understand and adhere to the label directives for each product used;
  - Utilize all appropriate personal protective equipment;
  - Adhere to and enforce company policies regarding the storage and handling of chemical products;
  - Understand and practice the correct mixing and transportation procedures for chemical products;
  - Learn and practice the appropriate plant health diagnostic skills;
  - Understand and practice the proper pesticide application skills;
  - Understand and implement drift control procedures;
  - Understand and practice all required record keeping and reporting procedures;
  - Demonstrate proper container disposal techniques.
2. Report for duty at the designated location on time each day prepared for work.
3. Be prepared to work as a member of a plant health care crew.
4. Learn and understand the dangers associated with electrical hazards.
5. Follow directions from a designated supervisor.
6. Learn, understand, adhere to, and help enforce all safety rules and company safety policies.
7. Participate in all safety training sessions offered.
8. Communicate effectively with a designated supervisor and staff members.
9. Interact regularly with clients to insure customer satisfaction.
10. Learn and be prepared to sell tree care services.
11. Strive to improve job skills and develop the potential for upward mobility.
12. Carry out other duties as assigned by a designated supervisor.
